## **Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Report**

### **Introduction**

The Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act (the "Act") requires that businesses state actions they have taken during the fiscal year to prevent and reduce the risk of forced labour or child labour within their operations and supply chain. This is a report for 219 Automotive Inc. o/a MacPhee Ford which has an obligation to publish a report under the Act. This report refers to the 2023 fiscal year end, being December 31, 2023, and describes steps taken by 219 Automotive Inc. in 2023 for the purposes of managing and monitoring its supply chain operations.

This is the first report for 219 Automotive Inc. o/a MacPhee Ford with regards to Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains.

- 219 Automotive Inc. is a part of the Ford of Canada dealer network.
- The dealership is located and conducts business in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, and it exceeds the revenue generation requirement and asset threshold to file the Forced Labour in Canadian Supply Chain Report.
- 219 Automotive Inc. is in the Retail trade of New and Used cars.
- 219 Automotive Inc. conducts business in the Automotive Parts and Service industry.

### **Assessment of Risks, Due Diligence and Verification**

As a retail organization, 219 Automotive Inc. works with Ford of Canada exclusively for the procurement of New vehicles. Based on the public report from Ford of Canada filed in 2024 (Ford Motor Company Global Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Transparency Statement for the Financial Year Ending on December 31, 2023), we believe the supply chain assessments

and due diligence conducted with suppliers and contractors to the manufacturing of Ford vehicles provide evidence that our supply chain meets the commitments required under the Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act.

### **Training**

The training required to maintain proper checks and balances in the supply chain are conducted by Ford of Canada. At the dealership level of the supply chain, there is training and awareness for Management through our Occupational Health and Safety Program to ensure we are compliant with current legislation. This includes, The Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act.

The Report was approved pursuant to subparagraph 11(4)(b)(ii) of the Act.
