It reflects a growing recognition of the importance of corporate responsibility and ethical sourcing. By holding businesses accountable for the integrity of their supply chains, the act aims to drive positive change, protect human rights, and create a fairer and more sustainable global economy.

Villeneuve Construction is mainly a Heavy Civil Construction company but the corporation owns quarries, produces and sells aggregates therefore we are defined as an "Entity" under the Supply Chain Act and must submit a report to the Minister of Public Safety.
