How We Work to Ensure Our Supply Chains Are Free of Forced Labour and Child Labour

Greenlite is committed to supporting the responsible sourcing of its materials from suppliers who share our values regarding human rights and ethics. Greenlite's Supplier Manual contains a Supplier Code of Conduct, which lays out the obligations of its suppliers. The Code of Conduct formalizes Greenlite's expectation that our suppliers be good corporate citizens and comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including those governing the manufacture of our products, safety, child labour, employment, labour and the environment. Greenlite takes its values and its Code of Conduct seriously and view it as the foundation and critical element of any supplier relationship. The terms and conditions of purchase further require sellers to certify that all goods furnished shall have been produced in compliance with all applicable requirements of CTPAT Minimum Security Criteria – Foreign Manufacturers – March 2020 booklet. Credible information regarding a potential violation of the Global Anti-Human Trafficking Policy and the Human Rights Policy, whether discovered by Greenlite, employees and agents, or suppliers and their employees and agents, should be promptly reported to the Greenlite Human Resources Department and prohibits retaliation against anyone who reports a concern in good faith.

Since 1994, Greenlite has not faced situations of forced labour or child labour and has therefore not had to remedy and rectify such situations and keeps monitoring and auditing our suppliers' working environment year by year.
