Supply Chains - Feedlot

- -Feeder cattle are sourced through order buyers
- -Feed grains are sourced through grain brokers and/or grain elevator companies
- -Veterinary medicines and feed supplements are sourced through licensed veterinary suppliers.
- -Supplies for feedlot maintainence including wood, steel, gravel etc are supplied through retailers.
- -Feedlot equipment is sourced through retailers/dealers

Supply Chains - Cropland

- -Seed for crops is sourced through seed retailers
- -Fertilizer for crops is sourced through fertilizer retailers
- -Equipment used in the production of crops is sourced through equipment dealers or auctions.

Employment Policies

On average, 20 employees are employed covering full time, part time and seasonal workers. As per our policy outlined in our employee handbook, Groenenboom Land & Cattle adheres to the Alberta Farm and Ranch Standards Legislation at all times. As well, we retain a safety consultant to ensure our workplace adheres to Alberta Workplace Safety Standards. On occasion workers under the age of 18 are employed. Groenenboom Land & Cattle has a policy for those workers which outlines enhanced supervision, limitations on tasks performed and hours of work. As well, Parental/Legal Guardian authorization is required before young workers can begin work activities.

Supply Chain Child Labour Risks

Groenenboom Land & Cattle has no knowledge of any forced labour or child labour used in its supply chains.
