Hunter Amenities has been a trusted partner that delivers a truly global solution for companies and brands in the hospitality and retail sectors. We are formulators and manufacturers of beauty and personal care products. Hunter operates as an entity in Canada under the Business number 102427283 RT0001.

Hunter amenities takes responsibility to be a more intentional and transparent about our labor practices including within our supply chain. Our major operations as manufactures makes us vulnerable to modern slavery in our supply chain. Beyond the legal compliance we ethically ensure fair treatment of all workers and safe working conditions.

We have identified the risks in our supply chain by

1. Engaging in Supply chain audits – we regularly carry out on-site inspections and interviews with workers.
2. Risk assessments- We have conducted an internal risk assessment to identify high risk geographic locations where we operate and considering industry practices and labor conditions that can put us at risk.
3. Stakeholder engagement- we engage our stakeholders so we can get insights and gather information on potential risks.

Our mitigating strategies include.

1. Developing a Supplier code of conduct which explicitly prohibits forced labor and child labor and ensuring compliance by requesting signatures from our suppliers.
2. We provided training for our employees on modern slavery risks and ethical labor practices.
3. We are committed to report compliance by publishing our progress and challenges in our annual sustainability report.

In conclusion we will continue to improve our due diligence process so that we can mitigate risks of forced and child labor, continue to foster collaboration with our stakeholders to share best practices, provide detailed, transparent, and accessible reports on our progress, continue to review, and improve our supply chain management practices to remain effective and compliant with evolving regulations.
