KCL Cattle Company Ltd. (KCL) is incorporated in accordance with the Business Corporations Act of Alberta. The company owns and operates three feedlots in Lethbridge County, purchases and sells live cattle, and farms owned and rented land Lethbridge County and Cardston County.

KCL is a family owned and operated business.

KCL follows government employment standards with relation to agricultural practices as well as additional requirements of LMIA's issued for temporary foreign workers. KCL primarily uses three cattle buyers to source feeder cattle. in rare occasions KCL will purchase cattle directly from local ranchers.

KCL purchases feed grains from a large number of grain brokers, both directly and through a related company Allied Marketing Group Inc.

KCL purchase other feed supplies for multiple companies. Medicines are generally purchased through Feedlot Management Services.

Crop inputs

KCL farms approx. 5,500 acres of irrigated farmland, and purchases seed, chemical, fertilizer and other crop inputs from a variety of different companies.

Sales Distribution Chains

Almost all fed cattle sales are to Cargill Meat Solutions and JBS Foods Canada.
