## Supply Chains Act - Report

### 1. Introduction

This report is made on behalf of Watkin Motors Partnership (“Company”) and describes the actions taken by the Company during the financial year ending December 31, 2023 to assess, prevent and reduce the risk that forced labour or child labour is used at any step in its operations and supply chains pursuant to the requirements of section 11 of the *Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act* (“Act”). This Report constitutes the first report prepared by the Company under the Act.

### 2. Structure, Activities and Supply Chains

The Company is a partnership based in Vernon, BC. The Company specializes in the retail sale of motor vehicles and parts as well as comprehensive vehicle servicing and repairs.

As a dealer of new and used vehicles and their parts, our supply chain is primarily based on the supply chain of automotive manufacturers. Specifically, as an authorized Ford dealer, the majority of the Company's procurement spend is with Ford. We also purchase goods and services from other third party suppliers. These goods and services could include office supplies (bought locally in Vernon), IT services (local in Lake Country), food and beverage supplies (bought locally in Vernon and Kelowna), and parts for resale (86.4% Ford, 13.6% non-Ford).

### 4. Assessment of Forced Labour and Child Labour Risks

The Company has not independently engaged in its own risk assessment with regards to forced labour or child labour in its supply chain. As the majority of the Company's supply chain is based on the supply chain of Ford, it relies on the assessment undertaken by Ford with regards to the extent of this risk. **8. Assessing Effectiveness**

The Company has not taken any action to assess its effectiveness in addressing risks of forced labour and child labour in its activities and supply chains.
