The organization recognizes the importance of preventing and mitigating the risk of forced labour and child labour within its supply chain. Greenway Metal Processors Ltd., is currently seeking to establish a relationship with an independent third-party advisor to assist in the development and implementation of processes intended to support compliance with the Canada Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in supply chains act (Bill S-211).

Steps Taken

As part of the company's initiative, the organization will evaluate sourcing practices and supply chain oversight procedures to identify opportunities for improvement. The engagement of external expertise is intended to support the creation of internal policies, supplier diligence measures, and monitoring processes to mitigate potential risks of forced labour and child labour within our organizations supply chain.

As a wholesale distributor that purchases products in bulk directly from manufacturers and through auction houses, the organization has begun preliminary discussions regarding the development of processes to identify and monitor potential risks of forced labour and child labour within its supply chain. Given the nature of its sourcing activities and supplier relationships, the organization is assessing practical measures to improve supplier due diligence, increase transparency, and support ongoing compliance with Canadian reporting obligations related to forced labour and child labour risks.

Conclusion

While formal policies and monitoring procedures are still under development, the organization is committed to strengthening its internal processes and improving supplier oversight practices over time. The organization will continue to assess its operations and sourcing activities to support compliance with applicable Canadian reporting requirements and promote responsible business practices.
